

集團參與《第 14 屆國際基建論壇 》共促國際交流合作


The Group participated in 14th IIICF to promote international infrastructure co-operation



6月1至2日,<u>亞洲聯合基建控股有限公司</u>(「集團」)及子公司<u>俊和建築工程有限公司</u>參與了在 澳門舉行的**《第14屆國際基礎設施投資與建設高峰論壇》**。

是次論壇以「綠色引領 數智驅動 金融賦能 合作共贏」為主題,吸引逾 60 多個國家和地區的 700 多家知名企業和機構出席。參展期間,集團向公眾展示了我們的發展歷程、理念、創新技術以及所承建的「一帶一路」與粵港澳大灣區標誌性工程,包括菲律賓 NOVALICHES 至 BALARA 輸水 隧道 4 號項目、港珠澳大橋香港口岸旅檢大樓項目等等,吸引各地行專前來洽談交流,共促合作。
